1. Serve as preacher for Worship Assemblies
 - Establish a consistent discipline of prayer, study and reflection
 - Deliver quality Biblical, theological, pastoral sermons
 - Collaborate with (or leads) the worship planning process
2. Serve as teacher in the Adult Education Ministry
 - Function as a member of the Adult Education Ministry
 - Teach adult and/or youth classes regularly
 - Provide leadership and resources in congregational study of special topics
3. Serve as a key resource for the ministry staff
 - Work as an effective member of the staff team
 - Promote a collaborative relationship with other team members
 - Establish his own leadership credibility within the team
 - Promote and facilitate ongoing team development and education
4. Serve as a key resource for the Elders
 - Participate in (or lead) regular study/reflection session with the Leadership Team
 - Work with the Leadership Team in directing theological reflection in the church
 - Collaborate with the Leadership Team in managing pastoral or congregational crisis
 - Available for pastoral ministry of hospital/shut-in visits, weddings, funerals, and other special situations

 - Deeply committed to reflecting the image of Christ and His ministry in all aspects of his own life
 - Demonstrates a priority for time investment in prayer, meditation, study and preparation
 - Maintains the highest level of integrity and honesty in his life
 - Committed to the growth and development of his personal and church family
2. Educational
 - Theologically trained and immersed in the Word (advanced degree preferred)
 - Experienced with multi-generational, diverse congregation (minimum 8 years)
3. Leader
 - Able to provide visionary leadership in partnership with the Leadership Team in supporting the current vision of Broadway and modifying it as situations dictate
 - Gifted in leadership development of others
 - A team builder
4. Characteristics
 - Caring, compassionate concerned for people
 - Dynamic, enthusiastic, effective speaker and teacher

- Engaging personality with a sense of humor
- Seeks to grow daily in faith
- Holds steadfast to Biblical truths
- Willing participant with the congregation as an active member of the church community
- Humble servant leader
- Lives his life in the community such that people will see Christ and be drawn to Him

A successful candidate will not be responsible for:

1. Administrative duties such as staff coordination, budget management, facilities management, minister evaluation etc. While not being responsible for these types of duties, as a part of the leadership team input into each of these will be expected and utilized as a part of the overall direction of the congregation. Broadway has very capable ministers responsible for these duties.
2. Leadership of all church ministries. Again, as part of the leadership team input, guidance and development of the leadership of the ministries is expected.
